### **Post-Visit Activity:**

#### **Web of Culture**

Objectives:

- Students will learn how various cultures make up the United States, by showing what other cultures have brought to the U.S.

Materials:

- World map
- String
- Tacks
- Index cards
- Computer Access

Procedure:

- Have each student pick a piece of culture: type of music, celebration, sport, art ect. Pass out the index cards and have the students write their piece of culture at the top.
- Have the students research where their piece of culture comes from, They can even trace it through time and how it traveled to the United States.
- Have them write their findings on the index card and tack their card on the map were it originated. Use the string to trace its spread to the United States.

Questions to Ask:

- What does this map show you about Immigration?
- How does Immigration positively affect the United States?
